The report elevates the voices of groups facing greater barriers in terms of inclusion.



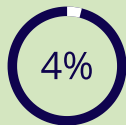
5,600 people living with disabilities *

 **Rapid population change**

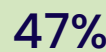
The pandemic hastened population changes, intensifying strains on our community.



77% increase in new residents (6,240 people) from 2016 to 2021.

There is also an increase in the number of people leaving the community (5,271).

 **Growing disconnect**



Nearly half of Canadians surveyed perceive their communities as more fractured than ever.

Prince Edward County is not exempt from the influences contributing to this growing disconnect.

27% of households have one occupant. Loneliness is now considered a public health issue, affecting both mental and physical health.
